Centralised video management, streamlining access to video, GDPR

Centralising surveillance from more than 160 cameras across The Kia Oval stadium and external sites into a single platform posed a significant challenge. Following any security incident, locating and sharing video footage with authorised third parties was resource-intensive and time-consuming, requiring staff to retrieve footage from multiple cameras and platforms.

- Consolidating systems into one platform: Integrating multiple video surveillance systems to allow authorised third-party users such as the British Transport Police (BTP), Transport for London (TFL), and the London Borough of Lambeth to remotely access video footage.
- **Optimising existing cameras:** Using the on-site security cameras that were already in place, including many high-quality cameras, to preserve initial investment.
- **GDPR compliance:** Ensuring a cybersecure, GDPR-aligned environment for retention and for sharing video with third parties. video with third parties.

The Solution:

Custom cloud solution to boost operational efficiency and security management

ABN Integrated Services worked with Eagle Eye Networks to design a solution to address current and long long-term needs of The Kia Oval that integrated 160+ existing cameras into a single, centralised cloud platform with additional Al and analytics. Authorised personnel can now access video footage anytime and anywhere, boosting both operational efficiency and security management.

Eagle Eye's user permissions allow third parties like Transport for London and the British Transport Police to remotely access selected cameras during specific times. This is important for crowd management on match days, when TFL uses the cameras to monitor the exterior of the stadium and watch the flow of spectators toward the Vauxhall and Oval subway stations. This selective camera access helps The Kia Oval and specified third parties run sporting events efficiently while **maintaining GDPR compliance.**

Also contributing to GDPR compliance are Eagle Eye's built-in features such as data encryption, multi-factor authentication, flexible data retention, secure sharing, and robust audit capabilities.
